- Giving pupils access to a wide range of post-16 pathways and supporting them to make the best choice for them
- Educating pupils about university and apprenticeships so that these experiences seem accessible and normal for pupils from our area
- Providing a careers education programme in school which develops their understanding of the world of work and also encourages them to reflect on their strengths and areas for development
- Supporting pupils to gain an experience of work through partnerships with industry and placements

Measuring and assessing the impact of our careers programme on pupils

We use a variety of different measures to ensure that our careers programme is effective. These methods include:

- Engaging with ex-pupils to find out whether the careers programme met their needs
- Promotion of achievements and pathways of ex-pupils around the school
- Engaging ex-pupils to work with pupils and to provide real-life experiences of the world of work
